

The group's sponsor and director, Cian Hazen, schedules two-hour rehearsals but they often run long. Several members of the troupe tease freshman Toby Henson for making the practices run overtime. "Toby does makes them run longer," allows Briscoe. "We're ADD-friendly," explains junior Tegan Thompson. Briscoe agrees. "This group is kind of hard to focus. Everyone's very

own ideas.' Whether the blame goes to the playwright or the young actors, there's just too much fun going on. Soon they'll have to settle down and produce a play.
