Everything Fitz brings fiddles, step-dance to Raton, Lamar

RATON – The kids are up front in Canada's Fitzgerald family band, Everything Fitz, with good reason. All four are national step-dance champions, and three hold national fiddle championships. They're all enrolled in ambitious college- or graduate-school programs, yet they manage to continue their long show-business tours, backed by mom and dad on piano and elec-

Everything Fitz has been touring the breadth of Canada and the U.S. since 2009. The show comes to Raton's Shuler Theater on Friday night, April 11, and to Lamar High School Auditorium in Lamar on Saturday night, April 12; both shows begin at 7 p.m. The two-month tour began in Minnesota on March 13 and will end on May 9 in Canada. Coming at the midpoint of the 47-show tour, the Raton and Lamar shows are the farthest south they'll venture before turning the bus around and working their way back north.

The Fitzgeralds feature high-energy fiddling and percussive step dancing. With roots in the Canadian old-time fiddle tradition and Ottawa Valley step dancing, their unique stage show combines a variety of musical styles — from traditional jigs and reels to bluegrass, jazz and swing



standards. They perform Celtic and gospel songs, as well as novelty numbers and choreographed dance routines. Six years of international touring have made them polished performers that provide wholesome, captivating entertainment for diverse audiJulie Fitzgerald, 24, is in her final year of a degree in Jazz and Contemporary Music at Toronto's Humber College. She's been winning fiddling contests since she was 6 years old and is now a two-time Canadian Grand Masters Fiddle Champion. She's also a two-time Ontario Open Step-Dancing Champion. She also writes fiddle tunes and arranges her family's music.

Kerry Fitzgerald, 23, is the current Ontario Open Step-Dance Champion and has placed high at the prestigious Canadian Grand Masters Fiddle Championship. She's in her fourth year on a full scholarship at the University of Western Ontario, completing both Kinesiology and Foods & Nutrition

At 20, Tom Fitzgerald is the family's youngest, but he's already placed fifth in the U.S. Grand Master Fiddler Championship in Nashville, and he holds the Canadian Grand Master title as his sisters do. Also skilled on mandolin and acoustic guitar, he has a passion for improvisation that has led him to incorporate elements of jazz, bluegrass and Texas Swing, influenced by Mark O'Conner and jazz legend Stéphane Grappelli. He's studying jazz violin at Humber College. As are his sisters, he's a serious multi-tasker: He once performed for five weeks in Branson, Missouri, as a professional step dancer.

That's the show's front line, sometimes joined by oldest sibling Pat,

25, who spends much of the show on the drum kit but is another Ontario Open Step Dance Champion. He almost won that championship again but placed second to his sister Julie. At the University of Western Ontario, he's completing his graduate degree in Pedorthics, following his undergraduate degree in Kinesiology.

That leaves mom and dad, Pam and Paddy, on piano and electric bass, respectively. They remain resolutely in the background, but their playing anchors the infectious rhythms that propel the entire show. The high points come when three fiddles entwine in spirited harmonies and when four siblings perform their award-winning group step dancing. It's a propulsive, thrilling show that has kept them on the road apparently around college studies — for six

Friday night's Shuler Theater show is the last in this season's Raton Arts & Humanities Council's Performing Arts Series. Reserved-seat tickets are \$20 for adults, \$15 for seniors and \$10 for students. Tickets will be available at the door for the 7 p.m. show. The band bus will make a U-turn on Saturday morning, beginning the return northward leg of its tour, with the group playing consecutive nights in New Mexico, Colorado, Nebraska, Wyoming and North Dakota. Saturday night's show in Lamar will be show number 26 in a tour of 47 shows. The curtain will rise in the Lamar High School Auditorium at 7 p.m.
