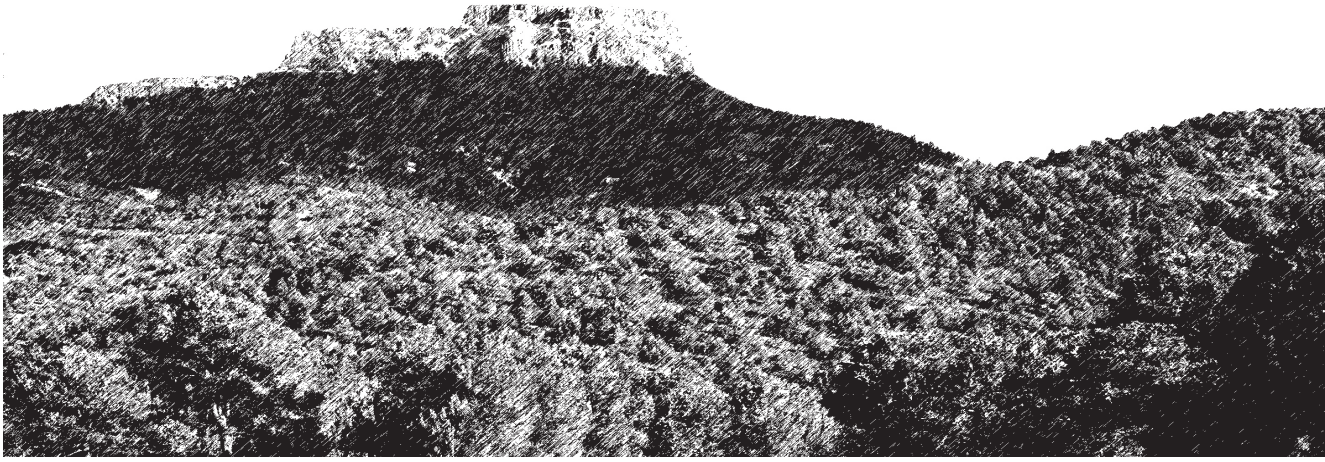


OVER THE PASS
