

Local cowgirls win National Little Britches Rodeo titles

A couple of Hoehne's finest young cowgirls came home world champions in the National Little Britches Rodeo Finals held in Pueblo on July 21-26.

Jaylynn Tortorelli, the 14 year-old daughter of Jarrod and Jonnalea Tortorelli and Hoehne student, competed in team roping, breakaway roping, goat tying and dally ribbon roping. She finished the year as the World Champion in Junior Girls Breakaway Roping and came home with a trophy saddle, four buckles, a pair of spurs and a scholarship for her efforts.

Shaelyn Walton is the 14 year-old daughter of Josh and Renee Whitaker and the late Sam Walton and is also a Hoehne student. Shaelyn competed in pole bending, team roping, dally ribbon roping, breakaway roping, trail course and goat tying. She finished the year as Reserve World Champion in the Junior Girls Breakaway Roping, and received three buckles, a pair of spurs and a scholarship for her performance.

Over 1,000 contestants from over 25 states competed for awards at the National Little Britches Rodeo. There were over 2,000 horses at the Colorado State Fairgrounds. This was a great accomplishment for these cowgirls — sought by many and achieved by few.
